The Embassy of the People's Republic of China in the Kingdom of Denmark presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark and has the honor to inform the following:

To block transmission of the coronavirus through cross-border transportation, maintain the continuous flow of international logistics and freight, and ensure the stability of the global supply chain, the Ministry of Transportation, National Health Commission, National Immigration Administration, Civil Aviation Administration and State Post Bureau of the People's Republic of China jointly issued a notification regarding the prevention and control measures at the Chinese borders concerning international air cargo crew. The relevant measures are as follows:

The crew members who will fly international routes after off-board rest should follow the guidance by Chinese municipal authorities of no-entry, no-testing, and resting collectively at designated location.

The local municipal authorities or airport will, to the best of their ability, provide the crew with a comfortable and enclosed rest area.

The crew should exercise self-discipline, not leave the enclosed area without authorization, and not enter public places at airport, designated hotel or guesthouse.

The crew members who will continue to fly domestic routes in China shall take nucleic acid testing at the first port of entry. Before the confirmation of test results, relevant prevention and control measures adopted by the local municipal authorities should be followed. Only those who test negative can continue to fly.

International air cargo enterprises may establish a white list for international aircrew who meet the health requirement, and the relevant airports shall facilitate the entry and exit clearance of those on the list.

The customs at Chinese airports shall implement the policy of rapid clearance for international air cargo crew. When necessary, the crew shall be given priority of quarantine clearance through special channels, so as to avoid their contact with passengers and reduce the risk of cross-infection.

The Embassy of the People's Republic of China in the Kingdom of Denmark avails itself of the opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark the assurances of its highest consideration.
